



### GREEN ENVIRONMENT

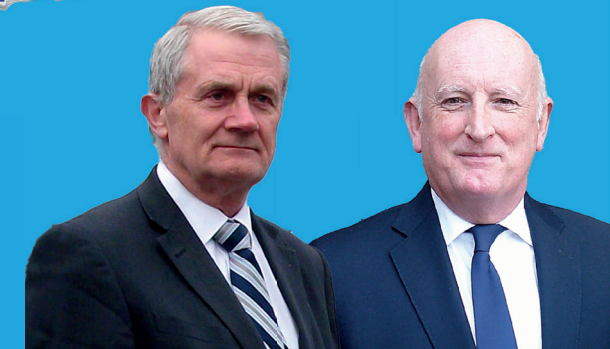
