Investing in infrastructure

Your Conservative team has secured record investme for roads and buses, with Kent's first electric bus service starting later this year between Whitfield and Dover. Planning is well underway on the future of Tides in Deal, building on the success of our new District Leisure Centre at Whitfield. Not forgetting £63 million of levelling up investment that will bring new jobs and training and help Keep Dover Clear of congestion.

Helping communities with the cost of living
